Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When does the dual membership partnership between LRSHRM and National SHRM take effect?

• April 27, 2021

Q: How does National SHRM and LRSHRM identify me?

• Both your National and LRSHRM memberships will identify you by your email address. It will be important for you to ensure your email address is the same with both National SHRM and LRSHRM.

Q: How will I pay for my membership?

• As of April 27, 2021 all members will now pay for their national membership and local membership in one transaction through National SHRM at www.shrm.org.

Q: How much will the total membership transaction cost me?

• Effective in 2024 LRSHRM dues will be \$60. National SHRM dues remain at \$264, making the total cost \$324 for both organizations.

Q: What if my National SHRM and LRSHRM membership expire at different times?

• It is our goal to align your National and LRSHRM memberships to renew and expire on the same date. Current LRSHRM members will not be invoiced for 2021 Chapter membership and will simply renew when it is time for annual renewal of their SHRM membership. Until April 27, 2021 those joining the Chapter for the first time will be billed the \$60 membership fee and will renew again at the time of their annual SHRM renewal at a prorated amount for Chapter dues (if applicable).

Q: I am already a member of National SHRM. What can the Lynchburg Regional chapter offer me in addition to my National SHRM membership?

• Being a local chapter member provides you with a local networking resource. You have the benefit of meeting other local professionals who are facing the same challenges that you are and can assist you with answers to your questions. You will receive invitations to LRSHRM's monthly chapter meetings, webinars, seminars and professional development opportunities. The majority of our programs have been approved for HRCI and SHRM certification credits, and we typically host 13-15 events throughout the year. Additionally, there are leadership and volunteer opportunities to assist in your professional development and to give back to the HR community.

Q: Why should I join National SHRM when LRSHRM gives me all I need?

• National SHRM membership is and has been a requirement of having a LRSHRM membership. The National SHRM membership offers many resources to save whomever manages the HR function time and money as they strive to stay compliant and create a great workplace for their organizations. SHRM has an Ask an Advisor service, offering personalized advice on specific HR questions or challenges, how-to guides, sample policies, job descriptions and interview questions, and more. SHRM members also get discounts on many professional, personal and travel services plus HR labor law posters, employee handbook builders, and much more.
